Illness at School	 Parents need to notify the school of any students preexisting conditions (asthma, allergies ect). These students should get a CoVid test before school starts to set a baseline If students become ill at school (shows CoVid / Flu symptoms) Students will be isolated in sick room in the office Parents will be contacted and required to pick up their child from school

*Close Contacts:

- Provide direct care for an individual with COVID-19 or who had similar close physical contact OR
- Had close prolonged contact OR
- Had direct contact with infectious body fluids of an individual with COVID-19 (i.e., was coughed or sneezed on).
